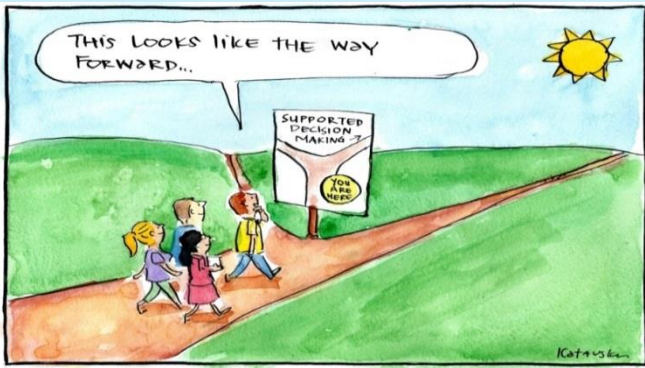


# Free workshops offered by the NSW Public Guardian on Capacity Building



The NSW Public Guardian is offering free tailored workshops for disability services staff to promote the human rights of people with disabilities.

We are offering two different workshops focusing on building the decision making capacity of people with disabilities.

One is an introduction to supported decision making (SDM).

The other is enabling risk in the context of SDM.

The training will be considered in the context of the NDIS and:

- Be suitable for Team Leaders, Ability Linkers, Local Area Coordinators and Key Workers
- Cover building the ability of people with disability to make their own decisions
- Focus on effective steps and strategies for providing support for decision making
- Discuss dilemmas and tensions, as well as strategies to address these
- Be run over one full day and includes lunch
- Offer an additional train-the-trainer component for the SDM course

The support for decision making course is a pre-requisite for the Train the Trainer course.
